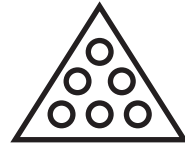
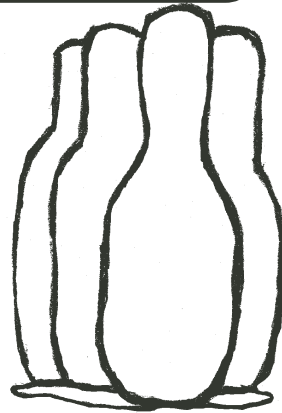
Here is an idea for things to make from odds and ends!

plastic bottle skittles



You will need:
6 or more plastic bottles
soft ball
sheets of plain paper
sticky tape and
colouring things

If you want to make this game very quickly, stick pieces of paper onto the bottles with numbers on them. Stand the bottles together and roll the ball to try and knock them all down. Add up the numbers on the fallen bottles. The one with the highest score is the winner. You could arrange the bottles in a line or a triangle shape or a square shape.

Decorate the bottles with different faces or patterns. Everytime you find another empty plastic bottle you can add to your skittle collection.

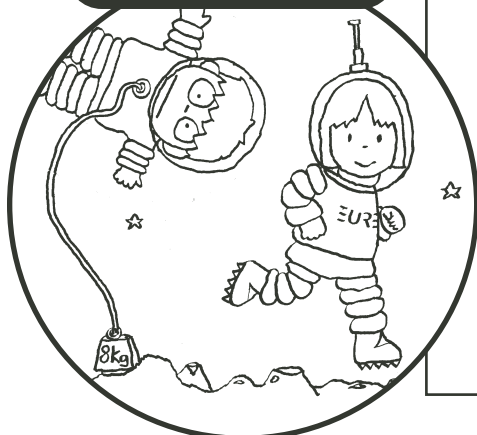
